Maxxis Tires and the 86CUP will provide a discount code to registered 86CUP participants to purchase Maxxis RC-1, VR-1 or VR2 tire products ONLY.

All 86CUP competition classes are eligible for the Maxxis Championship Prizes and Maxxis 86CUP Tire Contingency.

86CUP Presented by Maxxis Championship Prize Details:

86CUP and Maxxis Tires are offering championship podium tire awards at seasons end. Points standings can be easily tracked at <https://86cup.us/driver-standings/>. Tires awarded based on season end final points standing finishing positions will be as follows:

1st – 4 tires

2nd – 2 tires

3rd – 1 tire

NOTE: 86CUP championship podium winners are only eligible for championship prizes in one competition class.

2026 Maxxis 86CUP Tire Contingency Details:

86CUP and Maxxis Tires are offering the 2026 Maxxis 86CUP Tire Contingency for competitors running Maxxis tires during 86CUP rounds.

Every **10** (ten) championship points earned on Maxxis tires is redeemable for **1** (one) Maxxis RC-1, VR-1 or VR2 tire of the competitor's choice.



2026 Tire Contingency and Championship Prizes

Eligibility and Requirements:

1. Participants participating in multiple rounds must run Maxxis RC-1, VR-1 or VR2 tires during two or more competition rounds in the 2026 season and provide proof of purchase to be eligible. If participant runs only one competition round during the 2026 season, they must be on Maxxis tires to be eligible and provide proof of purchase. 2025 or older tire contingency program tires allowed by the 86CUP administrators during the 2026 season changeover “grace period”, in particular for Stock Class, are not eligible for the Maxxis Tire Contingency program, you **must** be on Maxxis tires to earn Maxxis tire contingency points.
2. Maxxis decals must be placed on the side of the competitor’s vehicle in highly visible/photographable spots such as the top of the front fender **-or-** quarter panel. Decals must be present on opposing sides (driver and passenger; view Reference A and B decal placements below) of the vehicle. 86CUP administrators are happy to provide decals for your use upon request.
3. Maxxis decals may be removed between events/after an event has concluded, but they must be present on the vehicle for the duration of each event.
4. By participating in the Maxxis 86CUP Tire Contingency program and/or Maxxis Championship Prize, participants agree to allow Maxxis Tires to use submitted results and 86CUP administrators’ submitted photos of Maxxis Tires branded cars in Maxxis’ marketing campaigns and promotions. Participants acknowledge that the participant owns usage rights to any photos and results, and authorize Maxxis Tires to re-publish submitted photos and results.

Tire Contingency & Championship Prize Redemption Details

1. **Redemption**
Eligible participants will redeem contingency tires by contacting Maxxis Tires’ designated representative directly. The Maxxis representative will verify eligibility and fulfill any approved tire (prize) claims. 86CUP administrators can provide the Maxxis representative details upon request.

Contingency tires will be awarded on a first come, first serve availability basis, while supplies last.

2. **Resale**
Maxxis contingency tires are for 86CUP participant use only and may not be resold. 86CUP will notify participants of these restrictions and any resale or attempted resale may result in contingency ineligibility.

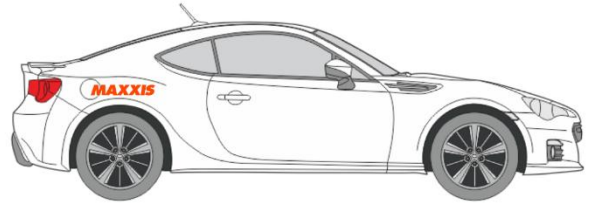

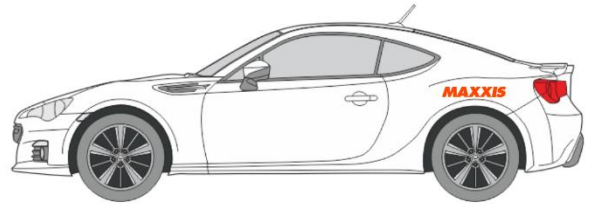
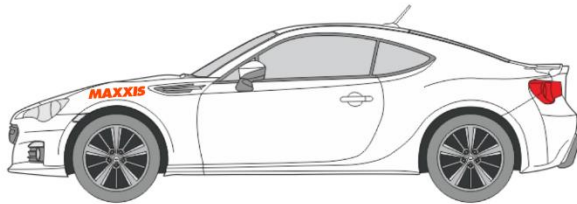
First gen – 2013-2020 Scion FR-S / Subaru BRZ / Toyota (GT)86



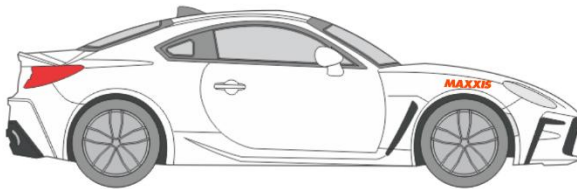
Gen 1 - Side Placement Reference A



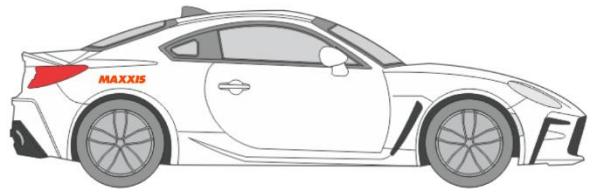
Gen 1 - Side Placement Reference B
